To whom it may concern:

On August 22, 2012, the Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”) adopted the “conflict minerals rules that were mandated by the Dodd-Frank Act. Under the rules, companies that file periodic reports with the SEC are required to make public disclosures regarding their purchase of respective minerals and certain derivatives thereof.

Although Weld-On is not subject to the conflict mineral reporting, as a company we put a high value on a sustainable supply chain and take the regulatory obligations of our valued customers seriously.

In that regard, based on our due diligence, we have been able to reasonably determine that none of the Weld-On product raw materials come from any countries covered by the reporting requirements listed above.

Finally, for future requirements, we will continue to buy from reputable and well established suppliers and will continue to take all appropriate measures to ensure that our products are conflict mineral free.
